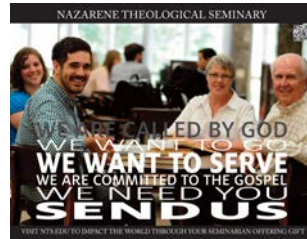

We have now assembled all the necessary building materials for volunteer projects this summer in Havana. Our 40 foot sea container is ready to be loaded in Indianapolis, and will soon depart from Port Everglades Florida, docking in Cuba twelve short hours later. This progress represents not only the completion of **Phase One** of our "Hearts for Cuba" plan, but also a major milestone toward bridging renewed friendship with our neighbors to the south.

Phase Two is also already underway as we continue assembling medical supplies for a second shipment. We look forward to the Spring when we'll join the Cuban Ministry of Health in welcoming these gifts that will be used to help improve the quality of healthcare throughout Cuba.

Phase Three (Summer 2014 volunteer projects in Cuba) is also developing according to schedule -- that's where you come in!
