Dear Pastors of the Illinois District:

Greetings in the magnificent name of our liberating Lord!

As you know, Dr. James R. Spruce has announced his retirement as superintendent of the Illinois District. We all celebrate his missional leadership during the past 11 years, and we pray God's richest blessings on him and Karen as they begin this new chapter in their lives.

As the jurisdictional general superintendent, I am writing to inform you that Dr. Robert Broadbooks, USA/Canada regional director, and I met with your District Advisory Council (DAC) on Saturday, 15 February 2014. The DAC is composed of the District Advisory Board members, the district secretary, the Nazarene Missions International president, the Nazarene Youth International president, and the Sunday School and Discipleship Ministries International chairperson. The purpose of our meeting was to review district superintendent transitional matters and to assist the district in preparing for the selection of a new superintendent. That election will take place at the assembly of the Illinois District on 17–18 July 2014.

In preparation for that meeting, a document will be distributed for each pastor and key lay leader to complete. The responses you give will help me and the DAC to develop a profile for the candidates to be considered for election as your new superintendent.

The DAC initiated a process in preparation for the assembly:

- 1. Calling the entire district to intentional prayer for the election and ministry of the new district superintendent
- 2. Opening a district-wide conversation to help evaluate the current strengths and challenges of the Illinois District
- 3. Opening a district-wide conversation to help create a profile of the district superintendent that is needed at the present time

Thank you for cooperating with the DAC as they request your input and participation in this important consultation. We look forward to working with you over the next several months. I believe that the best days for the Illinois District are ahead of us as we work together for the glory of God.
